Dugm Economic Forum

Governorates Marathon




Environmental Impact

This strategy, which earmarks three offset sites and extends the agreement by 25 years, is a clear manifestation of OQ8's dedication to minimizing its environmental impact. It reflects the company's broader commitment to integrating advanced technological solutions aimed at emission reduction and engaging in global sustainability dialogues. By doing so, OQ8 not only aims to preserve the natural habitats but also ensures that its operations are in harmony with Oman's rich ecosystems.
